National Agricultural Marketing Board Import and Export of Scheduled Agricultural Products Regulation Notice No. 8 (Amendments) Effective 1st February 2016

1.0 Registration

Importers, Exporters and Transistors of all scheduled agricultural products are required to apply and register for the year.

2.0 Export Permit

Valid for 6 Months Permit issued free of charge

3.0 Transit

Valid for 30 days Permit fee E550

4.0 Animal Feed

Valid for 30 days Permit Fee 250

5.0 Popcorn Import

Valid for 30 days Permit fee E250

6.0 Yellow Maize

Valid for 30 days Permit fee E250

7.0 Maize starch

Valid for 30 days Permit fee 500

8.0 Dried Leguminous Vegetables

Valid for 30 days Permit fee E250

9.0 Unused Permit

E75.00 fee will be charged for each unused permit

10.0 Surcharge for not returning a permit in time

E200.00 per will be charged for each permit not returned 5 days after due date for the first month. E300.00 per month for the subsequent month.

11.0 Lost Declaration Form

A search fee of E150.00 (not refundable) will be charged.

12.0 Responsibility

All permits are the property of NAMBoard; Importers are responsible for their safety keeping

Issuance of permit shall be stopped should a trader repeatedly lose his/her permit. E150.00 penalty (non-refundable) will be charged for a lost permit. Borrowing, sharing or renting out permit is illegal. A penalty of E500.00 will be charged from the permit holder if found to be misusing the permit.

13.0 Offence and Penalty

A penalty of 30% of invoice value will be charged on non/under/false declaration and smuggled scheduled products.
